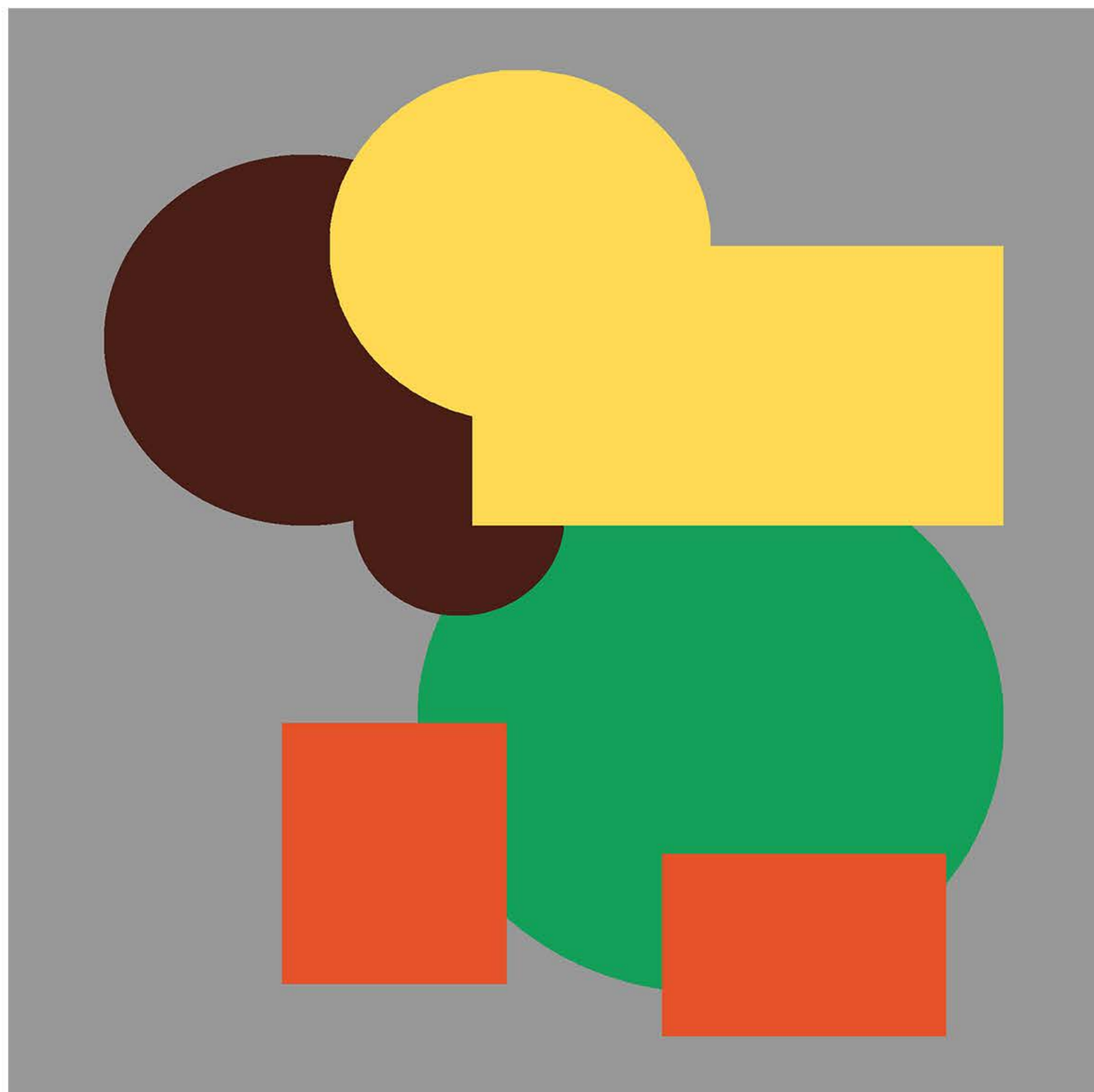


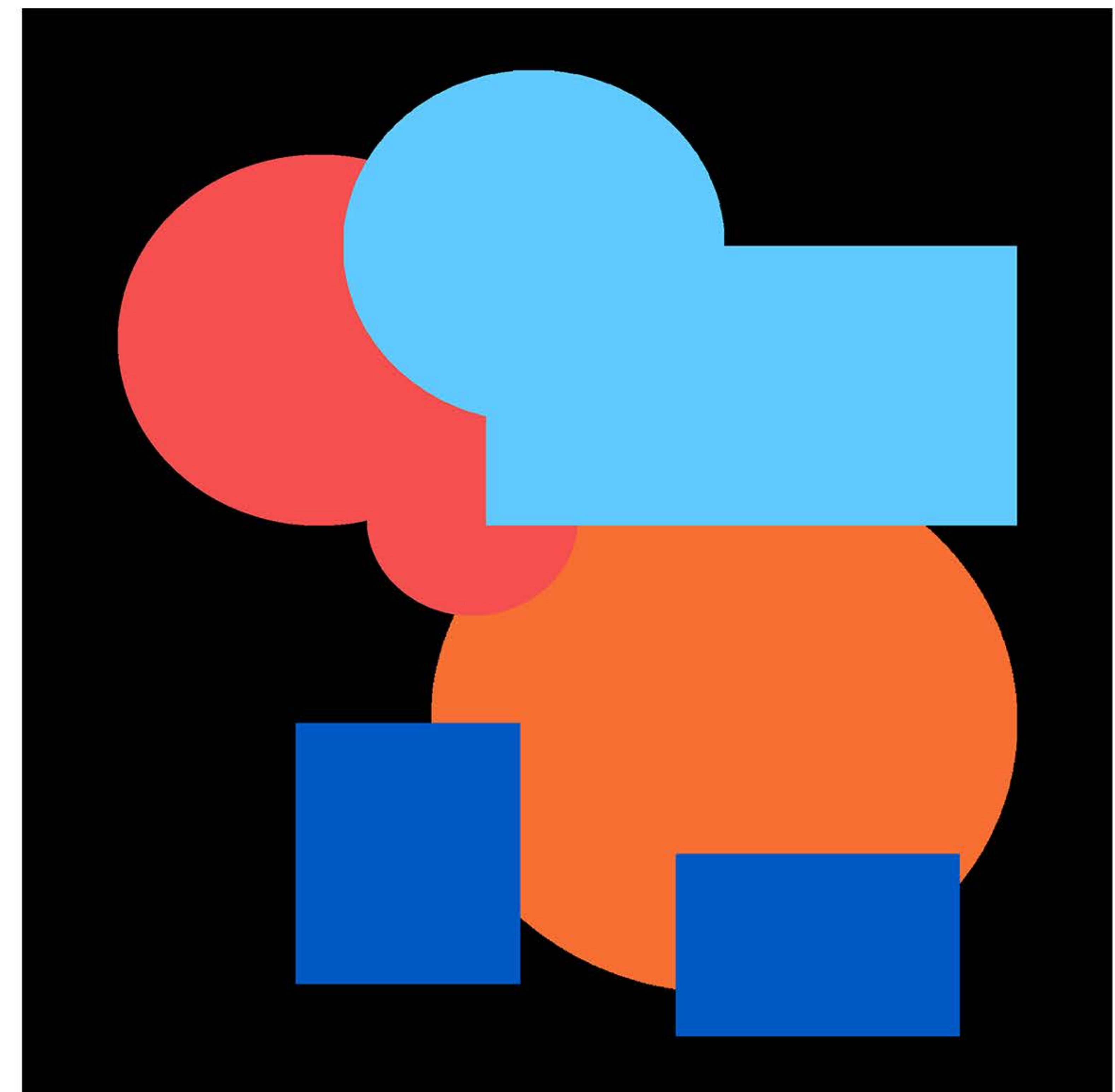
1. My color choices here were a representation of colors that I gravitate towards in my interiors and surroundings. These colors evoke calmness but are also vibrant.



2. These colors represent a deconstruction and reinterpretation of the colors in the Haitian flag. There are rich reds, blues and greens on the flags but I wanted the richness of the purple to signify regality instead of the blue which makes the palette stronger.
