Technology major. Besides being a student, he is also a singer-songwriter as well as a music producer.

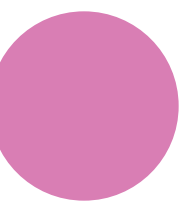

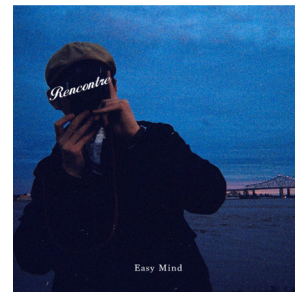
EASY MIND

In the early 2017, Easy Mind brought the fourth Indietronica album “Cloudland”, music involved with Ambient, Down-tempo, and Synthpop. The album title also comes from a traditional Chinese poetry “You only know you are somewhere in the mountain, but you never know where you are under the cloudland.” The infinity of depth and mystery of cloudland reflects Easy Mind’s persistence in his pursuit as an artist.



The album includes 10 pieces of music, and the titles also compose a sentence of poetry “Releasing the floating jade and the moon of mirage, stars are swinging on the serene and lucid path.” Except having a Chinese reference in the titles, the music has also included Chinese patterns—Chinese pentatonic melodies in tracks of “Jade” and “Mirage”.
