Notes taken during interview:

- Design is simple and straight to the point
- It's neater (normal craigslist is a jumble of words "Who said this was a good idea?")
- Likes the subcategories, less reading
- Posting is easier on mine, rather than multiple choice on craigslist which feels like a test.
- FAQ submit option is appreciated
- The amount of text on the craigslist original page makes you want to skip everything
- New log in /sign up is inviting as well as icons used
- Verification checklist makes it clear and organized
- REMOVE POINTS, can't be used on things if you're buying from people and not a company
- Instead, add a rating system for users to rate the people they buy from/interact with
- (In response to the original best of craigslist page) "why did they think THAT was good???"
- My Best of Craigslist page is better designed and though similar to the original, can stay the same.
- Homepage is neater than the site and less overwhelming. Menu is also a lot neater than the site
